

Rudolph Rally Fundraising Competition

Terms & Conditions

The Rudolph Rally fundraising competition is organised by St Giles Hospice, Fisherwick Road, Whittington, Lichfield, Staffordshire, WS14 9LH, registered charity number 509014.

By taking part in the Rudolph Rally fundraising competition, participating groups agree to these terms and conditions.**Awards and prizes:**

The three highest fundraising groups will receive:

Gold: £200 sports equipment voucher, gold medal, a winners assembly presented by St Giles Hospice and a certificate.

Silver: Silver medal, a silver award assembly presented by St Giles Hospice and a certificate.

Bronze: Bronze medal, a bronze award assembly presented by St Giles Hospice and certificate.

The £200 voucher will be awarded to the winning group and cannot be exchanged for cash.

How to enter:

To enter the competition, entrants must have registered to take part in the Rudolph Rally challenge and raise funds for St Giles Hospice.

The fundraising competition is open to schools, nurseries and other eligible groups registered to take part in Rudolph Rally 2026.

The Gold, Silver and Bronze places will be awarded to the three groups that raise the most funds as part of their Rudolph Rally fundraising.

There is no minimum fundraising amount required to enter the competition.

There is no additional fee to enter the Rudolph Rally Fundraising Competition.

Closing date:

The competition will close at midnight on Friday 12th February.

All fundraising to be included in the competition must have been received and processed by St Giles Hospice, this also includes offline donations.

General terms & conditions:

The competition is eligible to all registered participants who have raised funds and credited those funds to St Giles Hospice, as part of their participation in Rudolph Rally in December 2026.

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Fundraising can be completed through JustGiving, another online fundraising platform, or via sponsorship forms.

All fundraising must be clearly identifiable as belonging to the registered group, so that it can be included in their final fundraising total. Where St Giles Hospice is unable to independently verify fundraising through an online platform, the group may be asked to provide evidence of the amount raised. Gift Aid will not be included when calculating the final fundraising total for the purposes of the competition.

Only eligible fundraising raised by the closing date will be included in the final fundraising total. Fundraising received after this date will not count towards the competition.

When sending money to St Giles Hospice, please state the group or organisation you are fundraising with and 'RR' so that your fundraising can be correctly allocated.

The final fundraising totals will be verified by St Giles Hospice after the closing date. The Gold, Silver and Bronze winners will be contacted and announced shortly afterwards.

In the event that two or more groups have raised exactly the same amount, the groups will share the relevant placing. The winner will be contacted directly, using the information provided as part of their Rudolph Rally registration, to arrange delivery or presentation of their prize.

The winner(s) will be contacted by telephone or email and will be invited to take part in publicity.

St Giles Hospice will seek consent from the winner(s) before sharing any personal information or identifiable photographs on its social media channels or in other publicity.

The prize is non-transferrable and cannot be exchanged for cash.

By entering Rudolph Rally you acknowledge that you participate entirely at your own risk. St Giles Hospice, its trustees, employees and volunteers cannot accept responsibility for any injury, illness, loss or damage arising from participation in the event, except where liability cannot be excluded by law.

St Giles Hospice reserves the right to amend, suspend or cancel the competition where circumstances outside of its reasonable control make them necessary. Any significant changes will be communicated to registered participants as soon as reasonably possible. By entering the Rudolph Rally fundraising competition, participants agree to these terms and conditions.
